Animal Habitat Craft

Supplies (everything will be prepped and placed in the classroom)

- 1. Paper plates
- 2. Crayons, markers, color pencils
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Glue and tape
- 5. Coloring sheets

Procedure

- 1. Have the children choose their habitat and pick out corresponding coloring sheets with animals that live in that habitat.
 - a. Rainforest: gorilla, frog, toucan, sloth
 - b. Safari/savanna: lion, giraffe, elephant
 - c. Tundra: polar bear, seal, penguin,
 - d. Desert: rattlesnake, tortoise, fennec fox, hare, scorpion, vulture
- 2. Cut out a small triangle from the paper plate.



3. Make a crease in the plate by folding down the plate to the left of the cut triangle.



4. Repeat on the right side.



5. Draw and color the plate according to the habitat and animals chosen by the children.







6. Bring the two ends of the triangle together and tape.





- 7. Write verse: "In wisdom You have made all of them" -Psalm 104:24 (Optional to write out what habitat on the plate)
- 8. Color and cut out the animals. If children would like to position their animal to stand on the plate, help cut out a small tab on the bottom to glue down to the paper plate.



9. Glue onto the plate.



10. If time permits, children can choose another habitat to create.
