
## A Thousand Faces Craft (Part 1)

## Supplies

- 1. White card stock
- 2. Velcro
- 3. Paint
- 4. Paper plates
- 5. Paint brushes
- 6. Scissors
- 7. Pencils

## Procedure

- 1. Card stock paper must be cut in half in order to have correct size for craft. Ask children to fold and cut in half. Each sheet makes 2 faces.
- 2. Draw out outline of head on paper.



3. Cut out 6 pieces of the hook side of Velcro. Attach them to the place that corresponds to the forehead, eyes, nose, mouth, and neck.



4. Cut out head.



- 5. Write name on the back.
- 6. Paint the face and neck with flesh-colored paint and the shoulder area with a color to resemble a T-shirt.



- 7. Leave to dry. The rest of the craft will be completed the following Lord's Day.
- 8. When craft is complete, please return clear bin with supplies to the storage room. The brushes need to be washed. All the supplies can be left in the bin and put on the white table—no need to put back each individual supply.
