
Elephant Craft

Supplies


- 1. Blue and white construction paper
- 2. Googly eyes if available
- 3. Black and pink markers
- 4. Pencils
- 5. Scissors
- 6. Glue sticks

Procedure

- 1. Trace one's own hands and cut them out. Trace a big circle and cut it out. A template of the big circle will be provided.
- 2. Glue the two hands to the big circle as shown below.



3. Trace a narrowing strip on blue paper and cut it out. Trace two teeth on white paper and cut them out. A template of the trunk and teeth will be provided. Fold the narrowing strip to make the trunk.



4. Glue the trunk to the bottom of the face. The teeth are glued in between the trunk and the face. Glue googly eyes to the face if available.



5. Draw pink cheeks with marker. If googly eyes are not available, draw the eyes with black markers.



6. When craft is complete, please return clear bin with supplies to the storage room. All the supplies can be left in the bin and put on the white table—no need to put back each individual supply.

Giraffe Craft

Supplies

- 1. Yellow and black construction paper
- 2. Googly eyes if available
- 3. Black and brown markers
- 4. Pencils
- 5. Scissors
- 6. Glue sticks


Procedure

- 1. Trace one's own hand and stretch of lower arm. Trace teacher's hand and a stretch of lower arm on yellow construction paper. Cut them out.
- 2. Trace a pair of big circles and a pair of small circles on black construction paper. The templates of circles are provided. Cut them out.



3. Glue black circles onto the tip of the index finger and middle finger. If googly eyes are available, glue them to the face. If googly eyes are not available, draw eyes in the next step.

4. Draw two nostrils and mouth on the face. Draw eyes if googly eyes are not available. Draw brown dots on the body.



5. When craft is complete, please return clear bin with supplies to the storage room. All the supplies can be left in the bin and put on the white table—no need to put back each individual supply.
