
## Traffic Lights Craft

## Supplies


- 1. Black, red, yellow, and green construction paper
- 2. Paper rolls
- 3. Popsicle sticks
- 4. Pencils
- 5. Clear tapes
- 6. Glue sticks
- 7. Scissors

## Procedure

1. All material and tools are shown in the picture below. The double-sided tape is optional.



2. The shorter black rectangle is for wrapping the paper roll. The longer rectangle should be folded into five sections, with three circular holes cut out in the middle section. Each section should be slightly wider than the diameter of the paper rolls. Cut out a square from the red, yellow and green construction paper.



3. Use clear tape to coat a paper roll with the shorter rectangle of black construction paper. Glue the three squares onto the coated paper roll in zigzag positions. Fold the longer rectangle of black construction paper into a rectangular cube. Use the cross-shaped to make the top of the cube. Tape the popsicle stick onto the inside of the paper roll.

4. Place the paper roll into the cube. Turn the paper roll so that green light, yellow light, and red light is displayed one at a time.



5. When the craft is complete, please return clear bin with supplies to the storage room. All the supplies can be left in the bin and put on the white table—no need to put back each individual supply.
