
## Lantern Craft

## Supplies


- 1. White paper with the templates pre-drawn
- 2. Colored markers, pencils, or crayons
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Clear tape
- 5. Hole punchers
- 6. Strings

## Procedure


1. Cut along the outside border of the template.




2. Cut slit between two bottom squares.




3. Fold all the interior lines.




4. Decorate the outside. This project can be decorated as a lantern, a house, or other structures the children would like to.



5. Use a strip of tape to overlap and join the two bottom squares to make a base.



6. Use a strip of tape to secure the small flap to the first side of the structure.



7. Use tapes to join the remaining two sides to the base.



- 8. Punch a hole through the two of the top tabs that face each other.
- 9. Use a string to tie them together.
- 10. Cut a small slit into the remaining tabs. Slide them onto the tied together tabs. Secure with tape if needed.
- 11. When craft is complete, please return clear bin with supplies to the storage room. All the supplies can be left in the bin and put on the white table—no need to put back each individual supply.
