Topic: Creation – Man Awesomely and Wonderfully Made (1)

Note: The practical applications provided in the lesson are offered as suggestions to help the saints in their preparation. They are not meant to direct or limit the ways in which the focus of the lesson can be applied. The saints are encouraged to pray and contact the Lord to receive His burden and guidance in teaching and applying the lesson. Fellowship with other saints, and inquiring of the children themselves, may also bring out many helpful applications.

Elementary:

Verse: "It is He who has made us..." (Psalm 100:3b).

Focus: The top creature in creation is man. When we look at the different things our body can

do, we have to declare that God made us. Our mouth and nose are awesome and

wonderful in what they can do.

Practical Application: Without our mouth we could not get food into our body, taste, or speak. Did you know that our tongue has 3,000 taste buds and that man speaks over 5,000 languages? What if our nose was upside down or if we did not have little hairs in our nose? Water would flow in, and dust and other particles would get in. We were made specifically with a mouth to eat and to speak and with a nose to smell. (See the booklet, "There is God," published by Living Stream Ministry, also available online).

Intermediate:

Verse: "The hearing ear and the seeing eye—Jehovah has made both of them" (Proverbs 20:12).

Focus: The top creature in creation is man. When we look at the different things our body can

do, we have to declare that God made us. Our ears are awesome and wonderful in what

they can do.

Practical Application: Our ears take sound waves and turn it into what we hear as speech and music. (You can get into more detail.) Ears not only help us hear but also help us balance. Our ears have ear wax with chemicals to fight off infection, protect the skin of the ear canal, assist in cleaning and lubrication, and provide protection from bacteria, fungi, insects, and water.

Advanced:

Verse: "I will praise You, for I am awesomely and wonderfully made" (Psalm 139:14a).

Focus: The top creature in creation is man. When we look at the different things our body can

do, we have to declare that God made us. Our eyes are awesome and wonderful in what

they can do.

Practical Application: Our eyes have 107 million cells which are sensitive to light. Seven million cells help us see color and details. One hundred million cells help us see in the dark. Our eyes blink to wash tears over our eyeballs to keep them clean and moist. They also automatically blink if something is about to hit our eyes. Our eyelashes and eyebrows were placed by God just at the right places to protect our eyes.
