

Activity Plan for the Lesson on “God is Holy” for 3-5 Grades

A craft and an activity are planned for this lesson.

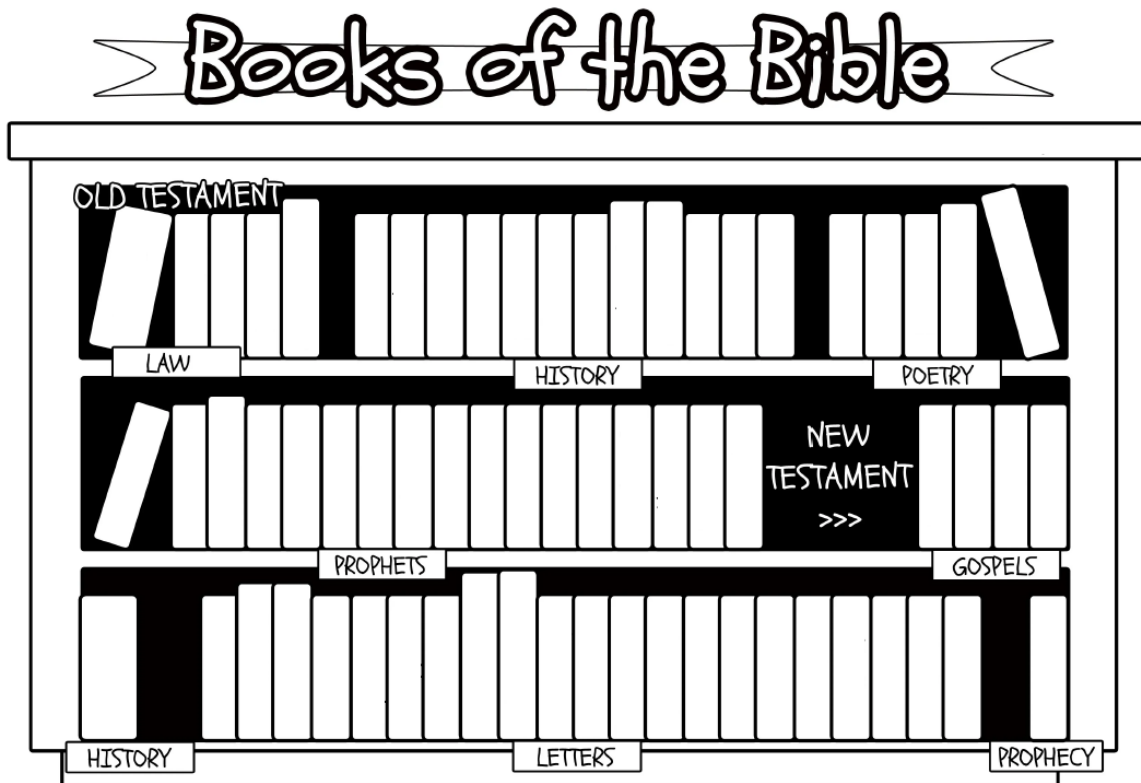
Crafts

Supplies (all the following are prepared and placed in the classroom)

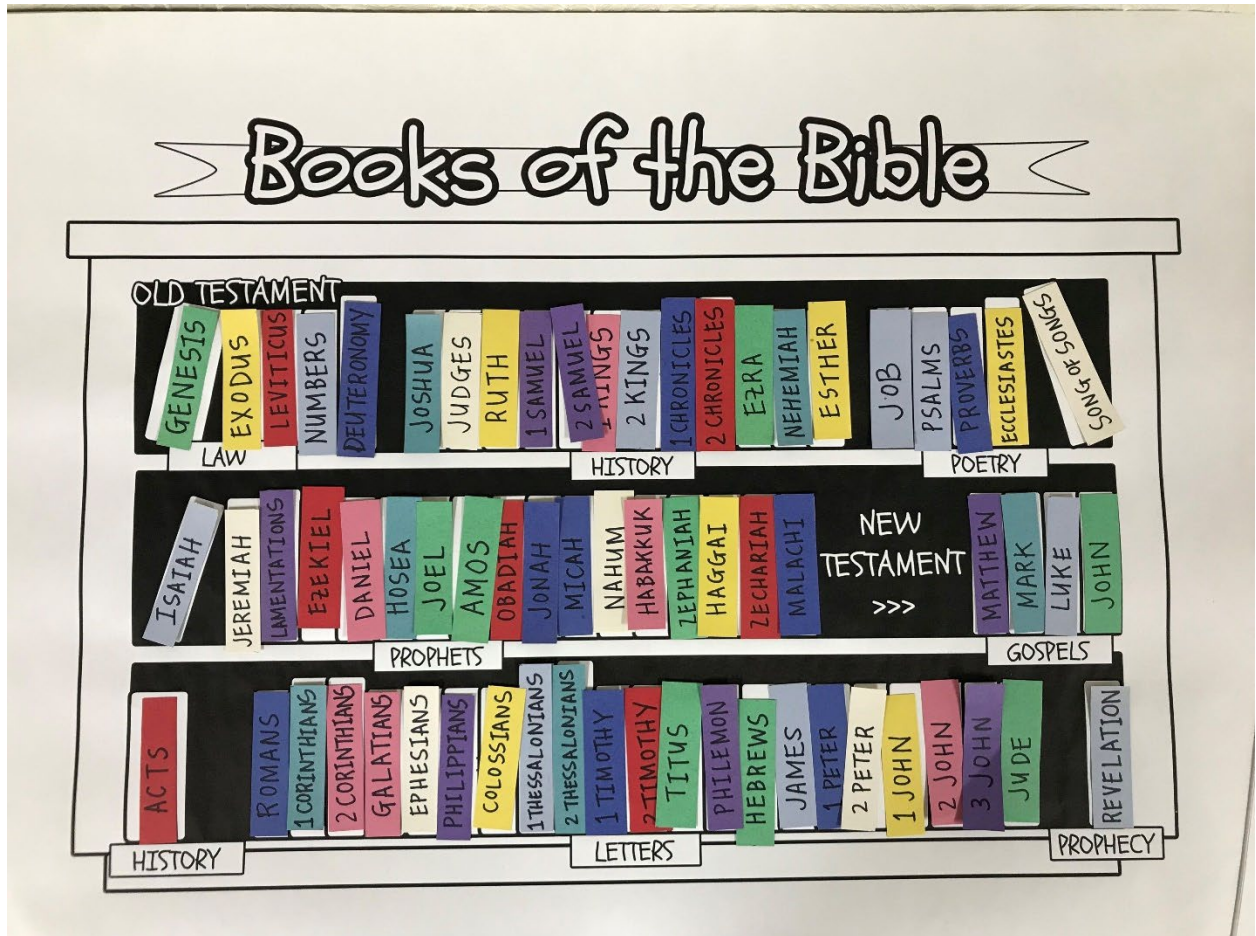
- A poster as shown below is placed on the wall of the classroom. There are 39 books of the Old Testament and 27 books of the New Testament placed on the bookshelf, with the correct number of books in each category placed as a group separated by a vacant slot from the next category.
- Pre-printed names of each book in the Bible on colored paper strips.
- Sticky dots to glue each paper strip onto the poster.

Procedure

1. Ask the children how many categories are in the Old Testament and how many categories in the New Testament.



- Have them work together to stick the pre-printed name of each book on a colored paper strip onto the right book. Sticky dots are provided as the gluing agent. A template of the final product is shown below.



Activity

Supplies (all the following are prepared and placed in the classroom)

- Ping pong balls each with the name of a book in the Bible written on them
- Two bins labeled as "Old Testament" and "New Testament", respectively

Procedure

- Taking clues from the finished Bible bookshelf poster on the wall, have children get the correct ping pong balls into the correct bin.
