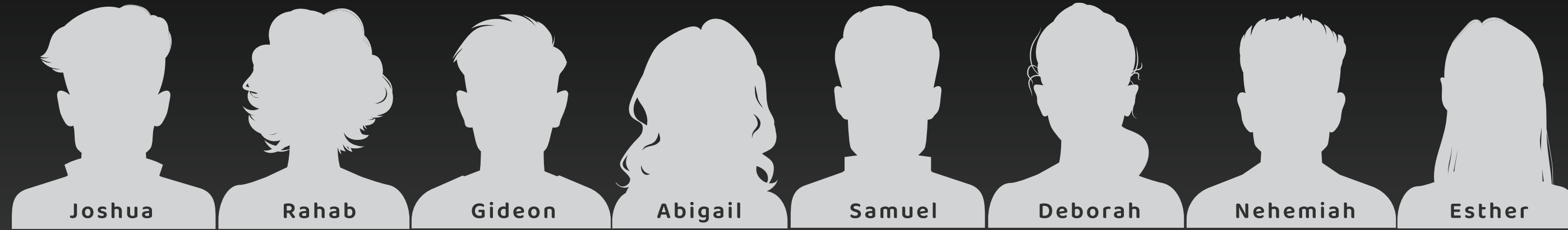

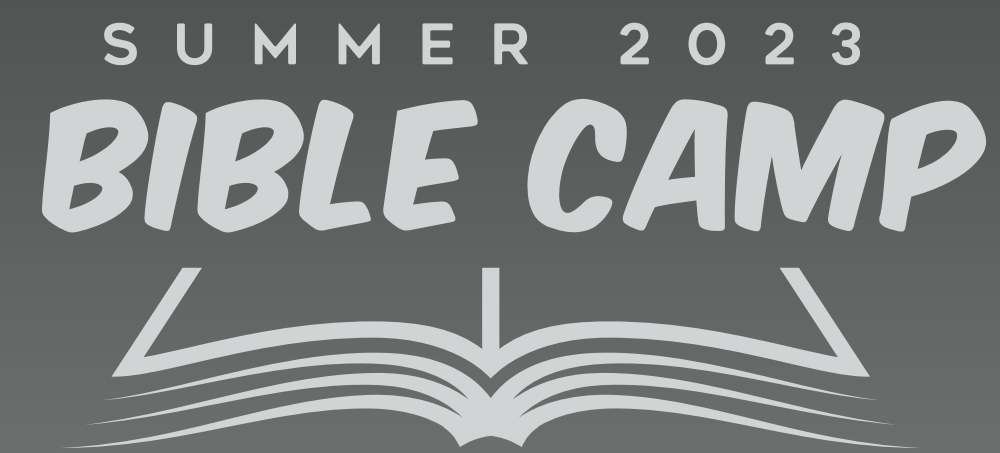


THEME SONG

When the walls came a'tumbling down.

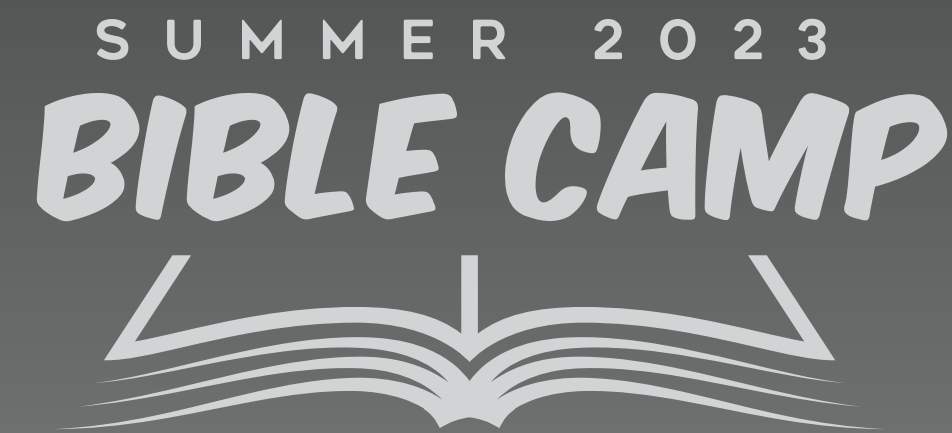
Verse 1:

And Midian’s army all ran, fled and cried!

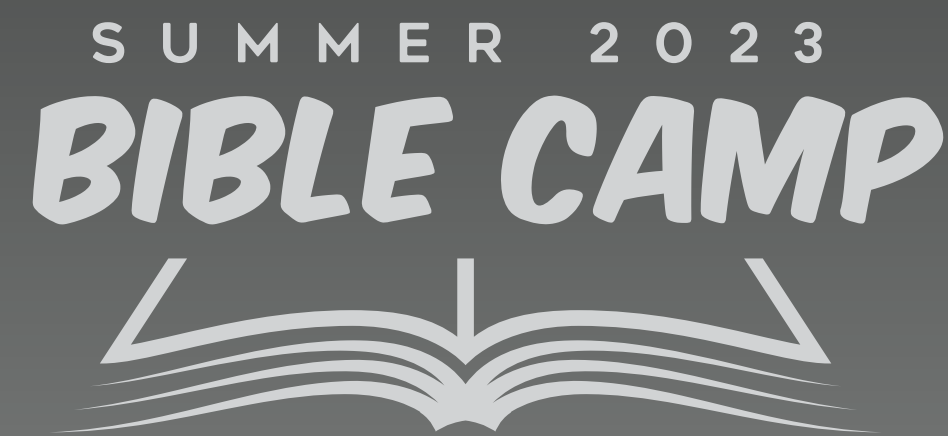

Brought... in... God's

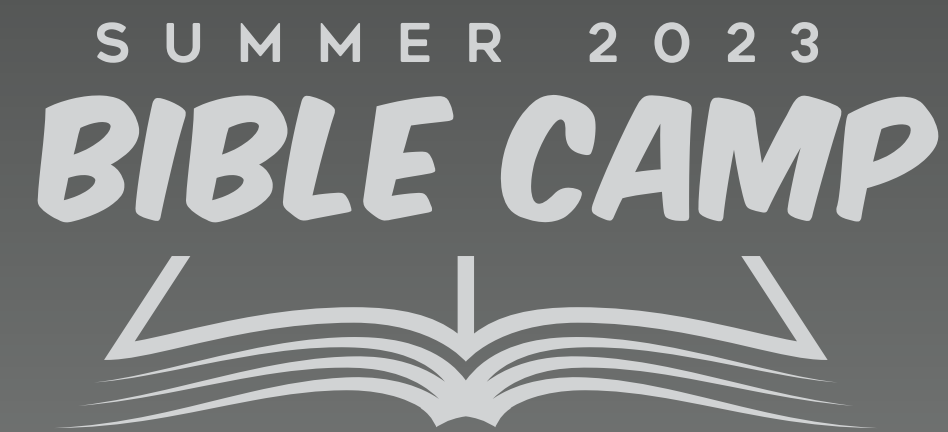
Kingdom... And he prayed!!!
